Subject: **Celebrating World Art Day - Reinterpreting the Masters**

The Art Department is organizing an engaging and enriching art competition - "**Reinterpreting the Masters**" in connection with the World Art Day Celebrations. We invite you to participate in the competition where you will have the opportunity to recreate a work of art by a Master Artist (full or a part of the painting) of your choice. This activity aims to deepen your understanding of art history, different artistic styles, and the techniques employed by these legendary figures.

Competition Details:

- **Event Name** : Reinterpreting the Masters (Choose any artwork created by a recognized Master Artist.)
- **Eligibility** : Students of Grades VI - XII
- **Size** : The artwork must be recreated on **A3 size paper**.
- **Medium** : You are free to use any art medium of your preference (e.g., pencils, charcoal, pastels, crayons, watercolors, acrylics, oil pastels, mixed media, etc.).
- **Description** : Along with your recreated artwork, attach a **brief description (approximately 50-100 words)** about the Master Artist whose work you have chosen. This description should include the artist's name, significant artistic period or style, and perhaps a key aspect of the artwork you have recreated.
- **Last date of Submission:** Completed artworks along with the artist description should be submitted to your respective Art Teacher on or before **Thursday, April 24th, 2025**.

Category:

- **Category 1** VI – VIII
- **Category 2** IX – X
- **Category 3** XI - XII

Judgement Criteria:

The submitted artworks will be judged based on the following criteria:

- **Interpretation of Originality:** While it's a copy, the effort and personal touch in the recreation will be considered.
- **Details in art work:** The level of detail and dedication evident in the artwork.
- **Understanding of Working Style:** How well the student has captured the essence and techniques of the Master Artist.
- **Presentation:** The overall neatness and presentation of the artwork and the accompanying description.

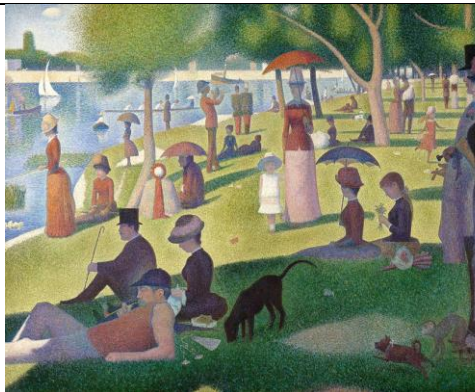

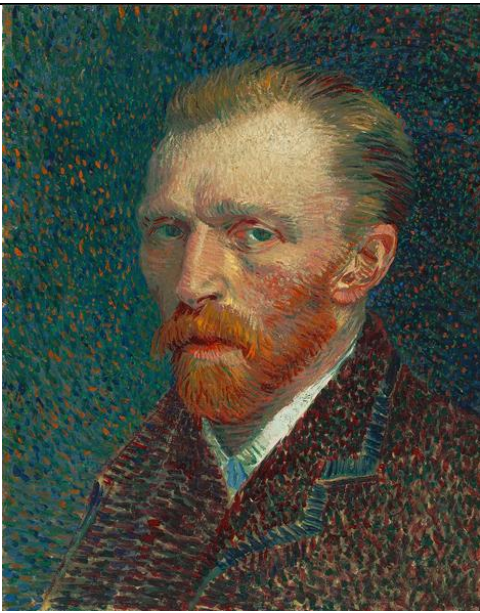

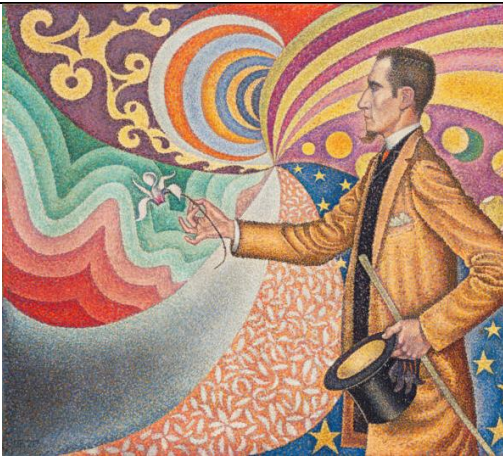

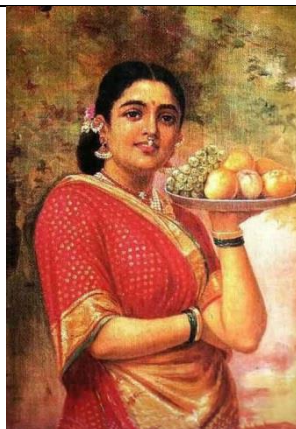
